CHIEF OF POLICE Position Posting

The City of Wayland is a small growing community conveniently located between the Grand Rapids and Kalamazoo metro areas. The small community feel as well as proximity to a significant number of amenities make Wayland an excellent community to call home.

Due to the planned retirement of the current Chief of Police, the City is seeking applications from qualified individuals to fill the position. The Police Chief provides oversight over 5 full-time officers, 1 part-time Lieutenant, and one clerical employee. Police Department annual budget is approximately \$800,000.

Qualified candidates will possess a Bachelor's Degree in criminal justice, public administration, leadership or a related field. The successful candidate will show progressive advancement and be responsible for and have demonstrated experience and competence in:

- investigation, patrol and traffic safety enforcement
- department administration and policy development
- planning and evaluation of department activities
- leadership and effective supervision of staff
- preparation and management of budgets and grants
- management of records and evidence
- department maintenance and operations
- maintains compliance and conduct consistent with the Michigan Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission (MLEAC) standards
- strong written, verbal, relationship and conflict resolution skills
- effective knowledge and application of local ordinances, state and federal laws
- taking calls, covering shifts and handling investigations in addition to supervisory/administrative duties
- community policing and public relations program implementation
- local ordinance enforcement
- 5 years experience is a requirement

The successful candidate will be a full time, at-will employee. Starting pay for the position will be \$68,000 to \$72,000 +/- DOQ. Competitive benefits include a defined benefit pension and attractive health care coverage. The deadline for applications is November 26, 2018. Those selected as finalists for the position will need to be available on December 18th and 19th for interview activities.
