The City of Wayland is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Part-Time Police Officer, currently we have 2-4 part time positions available. Wayland is located approximately 20 miles south of Grand Rapids in Northeastern Allegan County. The jurisdiction covers 3 square mile with a population of approximately 4200 residents.
