Wayland City Park 206 W. Maple St—Splash Pad Rules

- 1. Splash Pad is unsupervised—No lifeguard on duty. Use splash pad at your own risk. You are responsible for your children. Children under the age of 18 shall be accompanied by an adult.
- 2. Children requiring the use of diapers are required to use swim diapers in the splash pad area.
- 3. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- 4. Smoking is prohibited.
- 5. No running or rough play. Do not hang or climb on equipment.
- 6. Normal Hours of Operation will be 10AM-8PM from Memorial Day to Labor Day.
- 7. No food or drink allowed on the splash pad.
- 8. No glass containers allowed in splash pad area.
- 9. No pets allowed in splash pad area.
- 10.Patrons engaging in horse play or foul language will be asked to leave.
- 11.No bikes, skateboards, inline skates, toys, athletic equipment, balls, water balloons, or inflatable toys allowed in the splash pad area.
- 12.No objects (lawn chairs, etc) allowed on the splash pad.
- 13.Use of the splash pad is prohibited in the event of thunder and lightning in the area.
- 14.Splash pad surface may be hot—footwear is recommended.
- 15.In case of emergency call 911.
- 16. Failure to follow park rules may result in eviction and/or prosecution.
